

ENVIRONMENT CHECK

OPEN SPACES

- Regularly count the children in your area
- Set clear parameters about where a child can go (this may look like using your body as a marker)
- Spread out! Cover all areas of the space to ensure everyone is safe

NATURE SAFETY

- Remain aware of the surroundings (i.e. hazards on the ground, other paths)
- Share safety tips in concise and clear language (no abstract terms or metaphors)
- Use colour coding to show safety levels

FIRST AID PREPAREDNESS

- Always have a first aid kit available
- Have different sensory friendly options available when treating wounds
- Be aware of the different abilities to process pain

COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS

- Use walkie-talkies to communicate with other staff
- When giving instructions use clear and simple language; the fewer words the better
